In public forum, Nathan Fick presented Litwiller with the abstract for their property for her to look over.

Litwiller updated Council on Nuisance Properties and Delinquent Utility Accounts.

Discussion was had on Chapter 55 – Animal Protection and Control, Chapter 56 – Licensing of Animals, Chapter 57 – Dangerous and Vicious Animals. Litwiller explained that due to an incident last spring with a resident's dog killing a neighbor's dog the city attorney has advised us to make some changes to the current Ordinances. The public hearing will be set at the next meeting.

Council discussed Chapter 160.10 (11) Flood Plain Regulations. This change was supposed to be done prior to her coming on as administrator and was recently suggested from DNR that it be done. She will set the public hearing at the next council meeting.

Discussion was had on Chapter 52, Property Maintenance Regulations pertaining to Nuisance properties. This chapter is a whole new chapter that will be added. Litwiller requested that council give their opinions on whether they wanted to add this chapter or not. Consensus of Council was to go ahead and add. Public Hearing will be set at the next council meeting.

Discussion and action was had on service agreement with Kalonial Tree Services, LLC. Litwiller explained that the attorney had drawn up the contract with a \$20,000 cap. After Mayor Miller, Jared Miller and Litwiller discussed the contract they decided that it might be better to raise the original \$10,000 yearly budgeted amount for all ash trees being removed to \$20,000/year due to the progressing

disease. This will also get the trees paid for faster and won't restrict the budget for as many years. Philpot made a motion to approve, Freeman seconded and the vote was 3 ayes, Owens abstained.

With no further business Freeman moved to adjournment at 6:15pm, Owens seconded and all voted aye. The next regular City Council Meeting will be held Monday, December 17, 2018 at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers of the Wellman Municipal Building.
