The Wellman City Council met in special session in the Council Chambers of the Wellman Municipal Building at 6:00 pm. Mayor Ryan Miller presided with City Administrator, City Clerk, and the following Council Members: Robert Goodrich, Shannon McCain, Mark Philpot, Robert Freeman, & Tracy Owens. Agenda was approved upon motion by Owens, Seconded by Freeman and all aye votes.

Council had a discussion on the next steps in preparing for Ragbrai coming through town. Miller asked for anyone interested in attending the Ragbrai meeting in Ames on April 7th to please RSVP at City Hall by March 30th so transportation can be finalized. The route through Wellman was also a big topic for discussion. A deadline of April 7th was given to have the final route through town designated. McCain explained that he's talked with Ed Twedt, a vendor who's been involved with Ragbrai for many years and has scheduled a meeting with him on March 27th at 4:30. Ed will meet with all Ragbrai stopping towns and will then pick one town per day to set up in. McCain feels that Ed will have a lot of great advice and is recommending that we not make a final decision on the route until after meeting with him. Vendor fees was also discussed. Litwiller explained that this will be based on the expenses being paid out and how many vendors will be involved. Litwiller explained that we should have a lot more information after the April 7th Meeting in Ames. Ragbrai meetings were set to be the 2nd & 4th Monday's of the month beginning on April 9th at 6:00 in City Hall Council Chambers.

With no further business to be discussed Freeman moved for adjournment at 6:58pm, McCain seconded and all voted aye. The next regular City Council Meeting will be on Monday, April 2, 2018 at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers of the Wellman Municipal Building.
