The Wellman City Council met in special session in the Council Chambers of the Wellman Municipal Building at 5:30 pm. Mayor Ryan Miller presided with City Administrator, City Clerk, and the following Council Members: Robert Goodrich, Shannon McCain, Mark Philpot, Robert Freeman, & Tracy Owens. Agenda was approved upon motion by Goodrich, Seconded by McCain and all aye votes.

Discussion and action on Ragbrai Agreement was had. Philpot explained that the City of Wellman has received an agreement from Ragbrai needing approval to be a possible pass through town and needs our cooperation in setting a shut down time of 3:00 pm to ensure the safety of riders. They need to have an official response by Thursday, March 1. Litwiller explained that in the agreement they would need to name a Chairperson and also a co-chairperson that would potentially be able to attend a meeting/workshop on Saturday, April 7, if Wellman is chosen. Ragbrai anticipates to start publicly announcing the towns and roads on the route beginning March 11<sup>th</sup>. Philpot volunteered to be the Chairperson with McCain being co-chair. After much discussion with great input from residents in attendance, Freeman motioned to approve the Ragbrai agreement, Philpot seconded and all voted aye.

With no further business to be discussed Freeman moved for adjournment at 6:30pm, McCain seconded and all voted aye. The next regular City Council Meeting will be on Monday, March 5, 2018 at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers of the Wellman Municipal Building.
