A public hearing to receive comments for Proposed Property Tax Levy for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 was opened by Stutzman, seconded by Philpot and all voted aye. There were no oral or written comments.

McCain moved to close the public hearing, Fleming seconded and upon roll call the vote was unanimous ayes.

Resolution No. 20-07 A Resolution to adopt the Max Property Tax Levy for Fiscal Year 2021 was introduced and caused to be read. Philpot moved to approve Resolution No. 20-07, seconded by McCain and upon roll call the vote was unanimous ayes.

Resolution No. 20-08 A Resolution to set public hearing regarding the City of Wellman FY21 Budget was introduced and caused to be read. Public Hearing will be at the March 2nd meeting. Philpot moved to approve Resolution No. 20-08, seconded by Stutzman and upon roll call the vote was unanimous ayes.

Discussion and action on Ash Tree Removal was had. Litwiller explained the status on the Ash Tree removal and went over the payment status. She then asked how council would like to proceed when the upcoming contract ends September 30th. Litwiller will amend the contract and make sure that Miller is good with finishing out the remaining trees with final payment being made on July 2021.

Discussion and action on Alcohol in Parks was had. Litwiller explained that with the upcoming July 4th and the Mid Prairie Celebration coming up she was approached on whether alcohol could be allowed at North Park this year. Council discussed their thoughts on this and they would like to have this be based on a case by case with approval from council prior to the event. Litwiller will move forward with the process of changing the Ordinance.

Upon motion by Fleming, seconded by Stutzman and upon roll call the vote was unanimous ayes; Council entered into closed session at 5:46pm per lowa Code Section 21.5(1)(C) to discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the city in that litigation.

Upon motion by Philpot, seconded by McCain and upon roll call the vote was unanimous ayes; council entered into open session at 6:21pm.

With no further business to be discussed McCain moved for adjournment at 6:26pm, Philpot seconded and all voted aye. The next regular City Council Meeting will be Monday, March 2, 2020 at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers of the Wellman Municipal Building.
